

Proposed FAC Bylaws Change

Section 8.2 Association Legislative Policy.

(A) The Association may support or oppose legislation as dictated by the legislative program and guiding principles adopted by the Association and membership, or as directed specifically by the Board of Directors, the Legislative Executive Committee, or the Executive Committee. The Legislative Executive Committee shall be composed of the members of the Executive Committee, the chairs and vice-chairs of the legislative policy committees, and the chairs of the Rural and Urban Caucuses, and all past Presidents of the Association who are Members in Good Standing.

(B) Not less than seven members present of the Legislative Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum. In the event fewer than seven members of the Legislative Executive Committee are present, the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum and conduct the business of the Legislative Executive Committee.
