Automated Traffic Enforcement HB 325 by Rep. Reagan

SUPPORT legislation that would allow counties and municipalities to use automated traffic enforcement technology at intersections to combat the increasing problem of red light running.

- Supporting research demonstrates that when red light cameras are installed there are fewer fatal accidents.
- Trauma centers, rural health centers and public hospitals will receive additional resources to save the lives of people involved in head on collisions.
- The bill also requires a certified law enforcement officer to review the law violation prior to any tickets being distributed to the driver of the vehicle.
- There are provisions in the bill that will protect the vehicle owner in the event that the vehicle was stolen, yielding to an emergency vehicle, in a medical emergency, or cited by a police officer.
- This measure is an attempt to change reckless driving habits and increase the safety of all Floridians.
- Two counties have installed red light cameras and many others are considering installation upon passage of this bill.
