Q5 Cities and counties across Florida have long used their local powers to adopt a wide range of local laws that affect businesses. Cities and counties, for example, have adopted local anti-discrimination laws; tobacco and alcohol laws to protect young people; environmental protection laws like those that keep plastic bags out of the ocean or protect the coral reefs off Florida's coasts; laws regulating pain management clinics that contribute to the opioid epidemic; and other laws that aim to improve public health, protect the environment, and help create good jobs. Now, Florida state legislators are proposing HB 3, a bill that would invalidate all city or county laws affecting businesses and effectively block such local laws in the future.
