

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 22-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUWANNEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE DECLARED STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 ("COVID-19").**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") continues to effect the citizenry of our nation, state and county; and

**WHEREAS**, under the current circumstances, it continues to be the duty of Suwannee County to take protective measures to protect and support the public health, safety and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners declared a local State of Emergency on March 17, 2020, which was extended on March 24, 2020, to deal with such circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 252.46, Florida Statutes, authorizes and empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Suwannee County, Florida to make, amend, and rescind such orders and rules as are necessary for emergency management purposes and to supplement the carrying out of the provisions of ss. 252.31-252.90 not inconsistent with State directives.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Suwannee County, Florida, in emergency session, this 30th day of March, 2020, that:

1. The local State of Emergency shall remain in full force and effect for an additional seven (7) days up to and including April 7, 2020 unless terminated or modified earlier, or extended in accordance with law.
2. All provisions contained in the March 17th and 24<sup>th</sup> declarations are incorporated herein.
