DECLARATION ORDER 20-01
DECLARATION REGARDING THE CLOSURE
OF BEACHES DURING THE
CORONAVIRUS (“COVID-19”)
STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Bay County Board of County Commissioners approved Declaration Order 20-01 regarding the temporary closure of beaches to the public during the Covid-19 Local State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Bay County has continued its Declaration of Local State of Emergency because of the continued threat of Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, a threat to public health and safety continues to exist if the public is permitted to gather on the beach requiring the extension of Declaration Order 20-01.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The initial Declaration Order 20-01, which was signed on March 20, 2020, is hereby extended for a period of seven (7) days.

SECTION 2. As a result of this extension, Declaration Order 20-01 extends continuously from March 20, 2020, through April 3, 2020, inclusive.
