13	WHEREAS, Lake County is currently under a State of Emergency pursuant to Executive Order No.
14	20-51, as declared by Governor DeSantis on March 1, 2020; and
15	WHEREAS, COVID-19 has caused a significant public health emergency; and
16	WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, has
17	determined that a local state of emergency continues to exist and hereby declares an extension of the
18	Declaration of Local State of Emergency due to the significant impacts to public health and safety related to
19	COVID-19.
20	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners
21	of Lake County, Florida, that:
22	Section 1. Extended Emergency Declaration. An extension to the Declaration and Resolution
23	of Local Emergency is hereby declared for an additional seven (7) days.
24	Section 2. Effective Date: Duration. This Resolution shall take effect upon signature and shall
25	be in effect for seven (7) days or until canceled or extended as required by law.
