8	WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, Emergency Management governs Local Emergencies; and
9	WHEREAS, Lake County is currently under a State of Emergency pursuant to Executive Order No. 20-51, as
10	declared by Governor DeSantis on March 1, 2020; and
11	WHEREAS, Resolution 2020-29, dated March 16, 2020, of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake
12	County, Florida, declared a local state of emergency in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19"); and
13	WHEREAS, Resolution 2020-30, dated March 23, 2020, of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake
14	County, Florida, extended the local state of emergency for an additional seven (7) days due to the ongoing health threat
15	to those within the County related to COVID-19; and
16	WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-83 to reinforce the Centers for
17	Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines implemented as part of the "15 Days to Slow the Spread" initiative;
18	and
19	WHEREAS, Resolution 2020-31, dated March 30, 2020, of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake
20	County, Florida, extended the local state of emergency for an additional seven (7) days due to the ongoing health threat
21	to those within the County related to COVID-19; and
22	WHEREAS, COVID-19 poses a health risk to Lake County residents, particularly elderly residents and those
23	who are immunosuppressed or otherwise have high-risk medical conditions; and
24	WHEREAS, public health experts have consistently recommended avoiding close physical interaction between
25	people to slow the spread of COVID-19, and the CDC has updated and further restricted its distancing guidelines; and
26	WHEREAS, the CDC has stated that older adults and people of any age with serious underlying medical
27	conditions are particularly at risk for severe illness or death from COVID-19; and
28	WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, has determined
29	that it is necessary to issue this Emergency Order to: protect the health and safety of the residents and visitors of Lake
30	County, Florida; to assist the healthcare delivery system in its ability to serve those persons infected by COVID-19; and
