EMERGENCY ORDER 20-01  
REGARDING THE CLOSURE  
OF BEACHES DURING THE  
CORONAVIRUS (“COVID-19”)  
STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2020, the Bay County Board of County Commissioners approved Emergency Order 20-01 regarding the temporary closure of beaches to the public during the Covid-19 Local State of Emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, Bay County has continued its Declaration of Local State of Emergency because of the continued threat of Covid-19; and

**WHEREAS**, a threat to public health and safety continues to exist if the public is permitted to gather on the beach requiring the extension of Emergency Order 20-01.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The initial Emergency Order 20-01, which was signed on March 20, 2020, is hereby extended for a period of seven (7) days.

**SECTION 2.** As a result of this extension, Emergency Order 20-01 extends continuously from March 20, 2020, through April 17, 2020, inclusive.
