


AN ORDER EXTENDING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY  
DECLARED the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 2020.

PURSUANT to the authority conferred by Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and Gilchrist County Ordinance 94-09, ( codified in Chapter 26 of the Gilchrist County Code) as Chair of Gilchrist County Board of County Commissioners and after consultation with state and local authorities, that the COVID-19, presently being monitored by Center of Disease Control (CDC), that may create a severe threat to the lives of the residents in Gilchrist County, I hereby declare that a local state of emergency exists on March 20, 2020 in Gilchrist County. The State of Emergency may be extended as necessary in increments not to exceed seven (7) days each. The state of local emergency may be terminated by proclamation by a quorum of the board of county commissioners or designated official upon a finding that the threat or danger no longer exists.

**THIS ORDER** authorizes the activation of the Gilchrist County Emergency Management Plan and the exercise of all powers provided by Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and Gilchrist County Ordinance 94-09, (Chapter 26 of the Code).


