PROCLAMATION

SECOND EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the undersigned issued a proclamation declaring a local state of emergency in Hendry County effective beginning March 19, 2020, at 4:28 p.m., due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, local states of emergency continue for only seven days; and
WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, I issued an extension of the declaration of local state of
emergency; and

WHEREAS, as of today, at least four Hendry County residents have COVID-19 and COVID-19 continues to pose a threat to Hendry County, which requires that a local state of emergency remain in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Florida Statute 252.38 and Hendry County Code Section 1-2-55, I hereby proclaim, find, and declare:

- 1. The above recitals are true and are incorporated herein.
- 2. The local state of emergency currently in effect in Hendry County shall remain in effect for another seven days, until April 9, 2020, at 4:28 p.m., subject to extension in accordance with Florida Statute 252.38(3)(a)5. The County's disaster emergency plans shall remain activated. Hendry County staff remain authorized to carry out all of the emergency powers, as necessary, set out in Florida Statute 252.38(3) and Hendry County Code Sections 1-2-56, 1-2-58, 1-2-59 and 1-2-60. Hendry County staff remain authorized to carry out any other powers expressly or implicitly conferred pursuant to Chapters 125 and 252, Florida Statutes, and any other provision of law or County ordinance.
- 3. This authority shall extend only for the period of the local state of emergency, as continued herein, or until further action by an authorized person declares that the local state of

emergency has ended or that the local state of emergency should be extended.
