11	County, Florida, declared a local state of emergency in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19");

13	WHEREAS, the local state of emergency was extended for an additional seven (7) days via Resolution
14	No. 2020-30, signed on March 23, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-31, signed on March 30, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-
15	47, signed on April 6, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-48, signed on April 13, 2020, and Resolution 2020-49, signed on
16	April 20, 2020; and
17	WHEREAS, COVID-19 has caused and continues to cause a significant public health emergency; and
18	WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, has
19	determined that a local state of emergency continues to exist and hereby declares an extension of the Declaration of
20	Local State of Emergency due to the significant impacts to public health and safety related to COVID-19.
21	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of
22	Lake County, Florida, that:
23	Section 1. Extended Emergency Declaration. An extension to the Declaration and Resolution of
24 25	Local Emergency is hereby declared for an additional seven (7) days.
25	Section 2. Effective Date; Duration. This Resolution shall take effect upon signature and shall be
26	in effect for seven (7) days or until canceled or extended as required by law.
