

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-88**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA  
DUE TO COVID-19**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 20-35 on March 18, 2020 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to COVID-19 and adopted Resolution No. 20-77 on March 25, 2020, Resolution No. 20-78 on April 1, 2020, Resolution No. 20-79 on April 8, 2020, and Resolution 20-86 on April 15, 2020, each extending the state of local emergency by seven (7) days; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and


**WHEREAS**, the seven (7) day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of COVID-19, the County continues to address situations within the County, and there exists a need to extend this local State of Emergency to facilitate measures to protect citizens, visitors and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 22nd day of April, 2020 as follows:




