STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION EXTENTION SUMTER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) continues to pose an imminent health risk to the residents in Sumter County; and

WHEREAS, Florida State Statute, Chapter 252 authorizes the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to Declare that a Local State of Emergency exists; and

WHEREAS, The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioner declared a Local State of Emergency seven (7) days ago; and

WHEREAS, Florida State Statute, Chapter 252 limits each declaration to seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds that the anticipated conditions created by COVID-19 pose a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Sumter County.

THEREFORE, BY CONSIDERATION AND INCORPORATION OF THE ABOVE RECITALS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. This Declaration shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) days unless extended or dissolved.
