14	on April 6, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-48, signed on April 13, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-49, signed on April 20, 2020,
15	Resolution No. 2020-50, signed on April 27, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-52, signed on May 4, 2020; Resolution No. 2020-
16	53, signed on May 11, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-54, signed on May 18, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-55, signed on May
17	22, 2020; and
18	WHEREAS, COVID-19 has caused and continues to cause a significant public health emergency; and
19	WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, has determined that
20	a local state of emergency continues to exist and hereby declares an extension of the Declaration of Local State of
21	Emergency due to the significant impacts to public health and safety related to COVID-19.
22	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake
23	County, Florida, that:
24	Section 1. Extended Emergency Declaration. An extension to the Declaration and Resolution of Loca
25	Emergency is hereby declared for an additional seven (7) days.
26	Section 2. Effective Date; Duration. This Resolution shall take effect upon signature and shall be in
27	effect for seven (7) days or until canceled or extended as required by law.
