

State of Florida to Begin Disbursement of CARES Act Funds to Counties

The Florida Association of Counties (FAC) would like to thank the Florida Congressional Delegation for your leadership and letting your intent be known to the State of Florida that all counties are entitled to CARES Act funding.

Yesterday, June 10, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis announced the State of Florida's plan to disburse up to \$1.275 billion in CARES Act funds to counties with a population below 500,000. The United States Treasury previously disbursed over \$2.472 billion in funding to all counties whose populations exceed 500,000 in Florida.

Using a phased approach, the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) will distribute funds to the remaining counties, beginning with an initial disbursement of 25% of each county's allocation.


Florida Counties Continued Response to COVID-19 Pandemic
