## ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-33 REGARDING COVID-19

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, I issued Executive Order 2020-01 ordering a State of Local Emergency due to the public health threat posed by COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS,** no State of Local Emergency declared pursuant to the Florida Emergency Management Act may continue for more than seven (7) days unless renewed; and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 continues to pose a public health threat to the people of Orange County.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

- I, Jerry L. Demings, County Mayor of Orange County, Florida, acting as the Director of Emergency Management, promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:
- 1. The State of Local Emergency declared in Executive Order 2020-01 is continued for seven (7) days and may be extended in seven (7) day increments or less, as necessary, pursuant to Section 252.38(3)(a)5, Florida Statutes.
  - 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 2020-01 is ratified and reaffirmed.
