






#### **Registered Voters by Party**: 1990




### The relative number of voters registered NMP has nearly **quadrupled**.

#### **New Registered Voters by Party Since 2012**











#### **Net** Registration by Party





#### Registered Voters by Party: 1990 — Projected






## **Statewide Registration**: Party breakdown by Age NMP's are much YOUNGER than partisans.


