



HSJ Guiding Principles

Addition of HSJ 53 from HSJ-PP-04

• The Florida Association of Counties SUPPORTS increased state funding for the state corrections system to address compensation, retention, and recruitment of state correctional staff. As the state reviews the current prison system, the Florida Association of Counties SUPPORTS monitoring DOC review of state-operated facilities with particular focus on any recommendations that may impact local community employment and revenue sharing, as well as other local impacts and SUPPORTS minimizing any affects to local employment and revenue sharing resulting from DOC reviews.

Amend HSJ 33 from FAC Staff

• The Florida Association of Counties supports policies that protect the ability of counties to provide for coordinated, countywide systems of emergency medical services through the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Process, and not limit the ability of ambulance and other emergency medical transportation providers to be reimbursed for their services.
