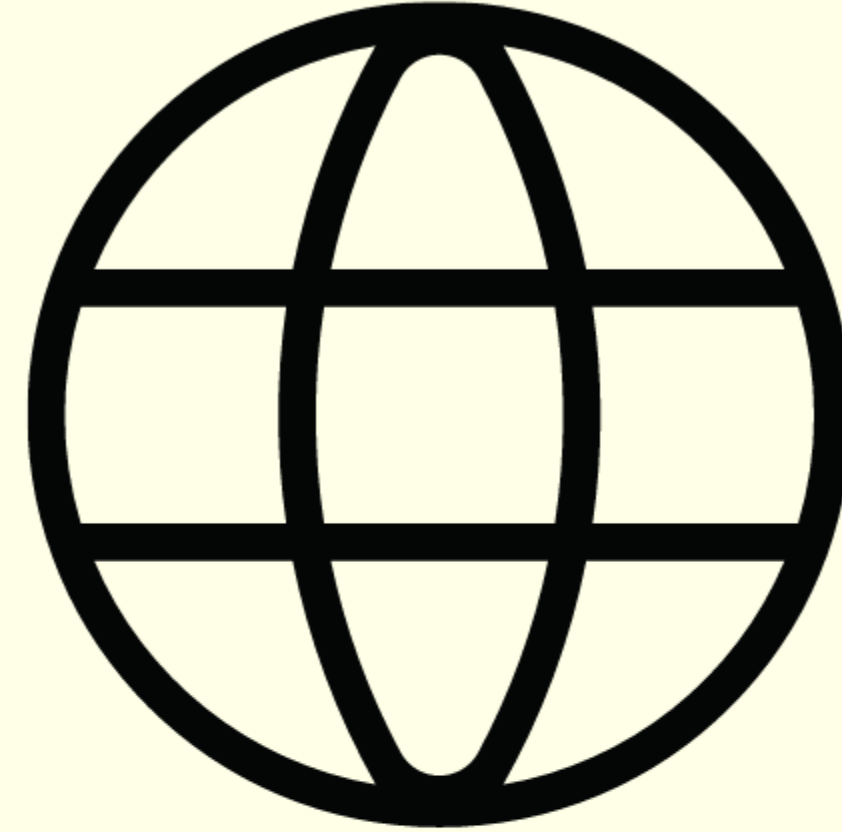

WES Guiding Principles

Modification of WES 2 from Chair Hamman

- The Florida Association of Counties supports state funding for water quality improvement projects designed to reduce nutrient pollution in Florida's impaired waterbodies, recognizing that multiple sources contribute to nutrient loading, including, but not limited to, stormwater runoff, wastewater and septic systems, industrial, agricultural, and residential water use.

Addition of WES 28 from Vice Chair Parks and Commissioner Dean

- WES 28. The Florida Association of Counties supports the acquisition of conservation lands that ensure the continued viability, preservation, and enhancement of the Florida Wildlife Corridor.
