



PROGRAM BACKGROUND AND DEVELOPMENT



WHY DEVELOP A PROGRAM?

Demand Social Science Workers

- Nationwide gap in the availability of nursing, counseling, and social work services.
- The nursing shortage, which includes a lack of Registered Nurses (RNs) and advanced practice nurses like Nurse Practitioners (NPs), is a significant issue in the United States. Projected shortage of 3.3 million nurses needed by 2031.
- Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) predicts a shortfall of over 10,000 full-time social work-related professionals by 2025, including counselors, psychologists, and marriage and family therapists.
- The gap between the growing demand for services and the availability of health workforce providers is predicted to widen, with the United States facing a massive shortages through 2036.


INITIAL QUESTIONS, HOW WILL WE ADDRESS?

• What kind of program can we create to support the deficit of service delivery healthcare workers in our County?

• Do we have internal agencies that provide behavioral health services? If so, what do we need from those agencies to develop a compliant program?

• How can we design a pathway that meets school credentialing requirements while also protecting the County from potential liabilities (students will need internal access, access to our clients, protected information, etc.)?

PROGRAM PURPOSE AND PLAN:

- Develop a proper title for program. University Student <u>Practicum</u> Program (USPP)
- Purpose of the USPP will be to provide students with meaningful learning experiences within Human Services agencies in Broward County.
- Plan is that students will be assigned to work with professional staff in accordance with state and university credential requirements.
- The USPP will provide an expanded pool of trained applicants who are prepared to work for Broward County agencies or in South Florida and relieve shortages in Human Services.

PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT:

- No other practicum model to follow in Broward
- Limitations to run a new program or compensate participants
- Took existing funds from a current position and converted it to create a new full-time position



STEPS TO CREATE A SUCCESSFUL PROGRAM

- Approval from County Administration and HSD Directors to lead initiative
- Identify agencies that could provide clinical experiences
- Meet with divisions Directors to pinpoint qualified supervisors
- Research/Meet with universities (local and national) that fit program model/majors
- Clarify how to protect private information of clients with agencies
- Connect with County Human Resources for onboarding requirements
- County Attorney creates standard legal agreement
- Board approved first few contracts (later amended for County Administrator to approve all agreements and amendments moving forward)
- Create a website per county policies. ADA complaint, standard county format

PROGRAM GUIDELINES/CHECKLIST

- 2nd year Master, Post-graduate or Doctoral level only
- Student commit to 2 semesters (8 months) to 1 year placement would benefit most programs and agencies.
- Create application
- Recruit 5 months ahead of each semester start date
- Process to confirm enrollment and eligibility of each student with University. Need to be enrolled during entre practicum, per contract insurance liability.
- Develop other essential program forms
- Determine level 1 and 2 backgrounds and TB testing
- Exit process

*This can be scaled up or down to the needs or resources in your County

PLACEMENT BEGINS!

The USPP started placing students in May 2020

Began with 4 Social Work Master level 2nd year clinical students

Clinical Placements Social Work



Practicum will include intake/needs assessment, case management services, referrals, discharge planning, a small caseload, individual and group therapy, recreational counseling, family counseling, therapeutic/ treatment planning, service plans, documentations, maintaining information on internal company systems, locating, and connecting clients with resources in the community, participation in outreach and networking services and professional development trainings.



Clinical Placements added for Master in Counseling and Master in Nursing, Nurse Practitioner and Doctoral Nursing

Broward Addiction Recovery Center (BARC) -Health and physical assessment for substance use disorder - 5 openings – Masters, NP, or DNP level students - Note: This Practicum is ONLY for MSN, Post graduate certifications in PMHNP/FNP/ANP and Doctoral Nursing students.

Practicum will include psychiatric training and medical training, inpatient detoxification, smoking cessation, MAT, an array of counseling which constitutes motivational interviewing, cognitive behavioral therapy, trauma informed care, mindfulness and recreational therapy.

The Family Success Administration Division (FSAD) provides emergency assistance and case management services through 4 programs to prevent the citizens of Broward County from experiencing homelessness, evictions, foreclosures, loss of electric and water services and assist with tuition, financial management, employment, transportation, nutrition, and childcare.

Practicum will include case management services, consultations, intake, assessment, care, discharge planning, documentation, maintaining information on internal company systems, connecting clients with needed and available community resources, preparing reports, occasional field visits, participation in outreach and networking services and professional development trainings.

PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- USPP started with 6 university partners and has grown to 23 partners from 15 higher education institutions
- 55 students have completed the USPP: -18 MSW Social Work/Counseling
 -21 MSN/NP Nursing
 -6 BSW
 -10 Administrative
- 12 students currently registered, all who complete placements by the end of 2025
- 9 students have been HIRED into the Broward County.
 - -6 BARC as Behavioral Health Clinicians
 - -1 Purchasing
 - -2 Office support roles within HSD
