Subject: FAC County Caucuses

Objective: Create Small, Midsize, and Large County Caucuses within the organization of the Florida Association of Counties to promote peer idea exchange and to facilitate research and learning among similarly situated counties in the state; and to ensure broad based representation in the governance of the Association.

Creation. The Board of Directors hereby creates three county caucuses within the Association, as follows:

Large County Caucus (LCC)

Participation within the LCC is open to FAC Counties in Good Standing, with populations above 500,000, as identified by the University of Florida's Bureau of Economic and Business Research (BEBR) population estimates, as of April 30 of each odd numbered year.

Midsize County Caucus (MCC)

Participation within the MCC is open to FAC Counties in Good Standing, with populations between 100,000 and 500,000, as identified by the University of Florida's Bureau of Economic and Business Research (BEBR) population estimates, as of April 30 of each odd numbered year.

Small County Caucus (SCC)

Participation within the SCC is open to FAC Counties in Good Standing, with populations under 100,000, as identified by the University of Florida's Bureau of Economic and Business Research (BEBR) population estimates, as of April 30 of each odd numbered year.

Chairs and Vice Chairs. The Chairs and Vice Chairs of each of these county caucuses will be appointed by the President for one year terms, beginning as of the date of the appointment and continuing until the position is either vacated or a new appointment is made by the President. Appointees may serve multiple terms, without limitation.

Purposes. Each of the three county caucuses serve as a forum for counties composed of similar demographics and interests. The purposes of each caucus is as follows:

- Provide structured forums for county leaders to engage with each other around common issues
- Promote idea exchange through research and learning
- Facilitate opportunities for participation and representation across all counties within the Association by electing a County Caucus Representative every two years to serve on

the Association's Executive Committee in accordance with the Association's Bylaws and Policies, as may be amended from time to time.

Meetings. Each county caucus must meet at least once each year in conjunction with Association conferences and events.

Elections. Each county caucus must elect a County Caucus Representative at the Annual Meeting of the Association every odd numbered year. The elections of the County Caucus Representatives are governed by the Association Bylaws, Board Policies, each as amended from time to time.

Reservation of Authority. The FAC Board of Directors reserves the right to modify, amend or abolish this policy by majority vote of any regular meeting of the Board or any special meeting of the Board, called for this purpose.
